Diphenhydramine hydrochlorde 25 mg.....Night Solubilized ibuprofen equal to 200 mg ibuprofen (NSAID)* (present as the free acid and potassium salt) *nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drug

 take a blood thinning (anticoagulant) or steroid drug

 take other drugs containing prescription or nonprescription
 NSAIDs [aspirin, luprofen, naproxen, or others]

 have 3 or more alcoholic drinks every day while using this

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product
 take more or for a longer time than directed
 Heart attack and stroke warning
 NSAIDs, except aspirin, increase the risk of heart attack,
heart failure, and stroke. These can be fatal.
 The risk is higher if you use more than directed or for longer
than directed.

- Do not use

 If you have ever had an allergic reaction to any other pain reliever/fever reducer

 unless you have time for a full night's sleep

 in children under 12 years of age

 right before or after heat surgery

 with any other product containing diphenhydramine, even one used on skin

 if you have sleeplessness without pain

Ask a doctor before use if

- Ask a doctor before use if

 stomach bleeding warning applies to you

 you have problems or serious side effects from taking
 pain reflevers or fever reducers

 you have a history of stomach problems, such as
 heartburn

 you have high blood pressure, heart disease, liver cirrhosis,
 kidney disease, or asthma, or had a stroke.

 you are taking a diuretic

 you have a breathing problem such as emphysema or chronic
 bronchitis

- you have glaucoma
 you have trouble urinating due to an enlarged prostate gland
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- Ask a doctor or pharmacist before use if you are
 taking sedatives or tranquilizers, or any other sleep-aid
 under a doctor's care for any continuing medical illness
 taking asylor other antihistamines
 taking asylorin for heart attack or stroke, because ibuprofen
 may decrease this benefit of aspirin
 taking any other drug

When using this product

- avoid alcoholic drinks
 do not drive a motor vehicle or operate machinery
 take with food or milk if stomach upset occurs

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 Stop use and ask a doctor if
 you experience any of the following signs of stomach bleeding:
 feel faint
 vomit blood
 have bloody or black stools
 have stomach pain that does not get better
 you have symptoms of heart problems or stroke:
 chest pain
 trouble breathing
 weakness in one part or side of body
 slurred speech
 leg swelling
 pain gets worse or lasts more than 10 days
 sleeplessness persists continuously for more than 2 weeks.
 Insomain amy be a symptom of a serious underlying medical illness.
 erdeness or swelling is present in the painful area
 any new symptoms appear

 If pregnant or breast-feeding, ask a health professional

If pregnant or breast-feeding, ask a health professional before use. It is especially important not to use ibuprofen during the

last 3 months of pregnancy unless definitely directed to do so by a doctor because it may cause problems in the unborn child or complications during delivery. **Keep out of the reach of children.** In case of overdose, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away

 do not take more than directed

 adults and children 12 years and over: take 2 capsules
- at bedtime
 do not take more than 2 capsules in 24 hours

 read all warnings and directions before use. Keep carton.

 store at 20° to 25°C (68° to 77°F)

 avoid excessive heat above 40°C (104°F)
